

Key Verse: But it is not so among you; but whoever wishes to become great among you must be your servant, ⁴⁴ and whoever wishes to be first among you must be slave of all. ⁴⁵ For the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life a ransom for many." Mark 10:43-45

Apply: I worked with a man who was extremely intelligent and well thought of in the engineering community. He did not thump his chest in meetings in order to be heard. He did not play politics to get his way. His greatest gift to all that worked with him was that he listened to people's thoughts and opinions and considered whether they might have a solution or a feasible idea. He did not consider himself better than anyone else. He did not consider praise essential to the task at hand. One of the greatest ways we can serve others is by really listening to them. Practice this way of serving this week.

Prayer: Jesus – we like to be acknowledged for what we do and know. Instead, let us be filled with Your Spirit and be at peace in serving others. May we be humble servants in Your sight. Amen.
