We live in a high-tech world where computers have become an essential part of our everyday lives. As helpful as computers can be, I also suspect that we have all developed a kind of “love/hate” relationship with our computers. Every so often, I see a message pop up on my computer asking me if I want to create “Back-up & Recovery Files” that would allow me to restore my computer to its original “factory settings” in the event that my computer should experience some kind of “CRITICAL FAILURE!” Typically, I will click on the button that says, “Remind me later,” because I know that creating these restore files can take a lot of time.

Today, as I was sitting at my desk, trying to think about what I wanted to write for the April church newsletter, I was thinking about the fact that Easter Sunday is April 20th, and the words “Critical Failure” came to my mind and connected with me in a new way as I considered them within the context of Easter Sunday. This is what God has done for us by sending His Son, Jesus, to die on a cross and by then raising Him from the dead. He has created a system restore option for all of us making it possible for us to recover from “critical failure” in life! There are no guarantees, no matter how new or old we are, “critical failure” can happen at any time. Only now, because Christ has died and been raised from the dead we have this assurance. Even though we die, yet shall we live! We shall all, on that day of resurrection, be restored to “new life”, free from all viruses, malware and faulty programming, restored and reclaimed by God to be just the way He created us to be from the very beginning!

Every Sunday, we are reminded of the power that Jesus’ resurrection has for setting us free from the fears and the problems of the world in which we live. The “New life” that Jesus proclaims begins now! Still, we are often tempted to push the “remind me later” button because the problems of the world can seem so overwhelming. I pray that this Easter we will together find the strength and courage needed in order to be restored by God’s love even as we continue to do the work of serving God, by loving others!

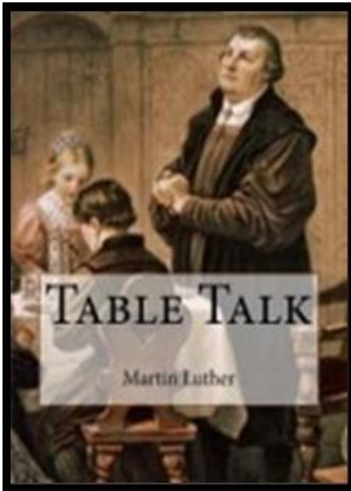

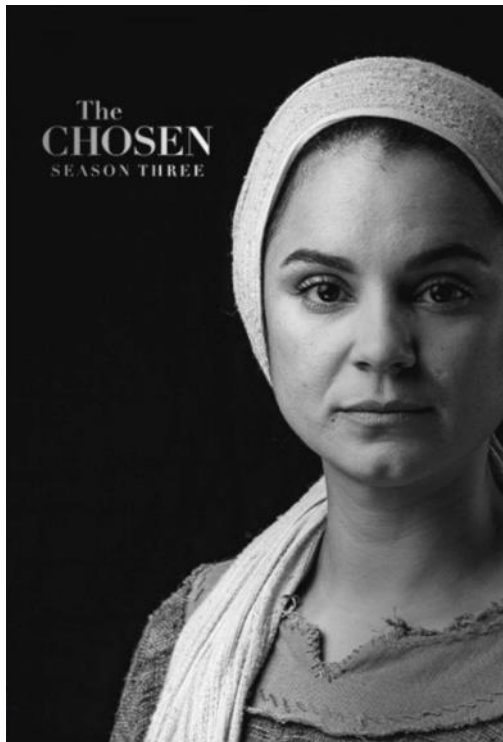

Romans 8:34 – *“Christ Jesus is the one who died – more than that, who was raised – who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.”*

I often think back to my days as a little kid, going to Sunday School at the United Methodist Church in Columbia City. My goodness, life was easier then. I didn't need to worry about anything because my parents and extended family would take care of me. It was good to be a little kid, right? But, then I grew up, and with growth came worries. I had the usual worries... would I pass my driving test, were these the right jeans, what should I do with my life. My biggest worry, though, was one I rarely voiced because there really wasn't an answer. I worried about dying. I didn't worry about the actual dying part. It was the after part that had me staying awake at night. I couldn't, and, honestly still can't, fathom the idea of eternity.

Eternity is even more vast than the universe. My Sunday School teachers taught me about a beautiful house prepared by Jesus just for me. I would join Him there when I died, and I would live with Him there forever. Then, others told me that's not exactly how Heaven works. But, then I read the above verse, and my worry dissipates a bit. Jesus was made man, died a human death, and was buried in a tomb. His Father raised Him from the dead, took Him to Heaven, and placed Him at His right hand. Jesus sits there and speaks with His Father for us every day, asking Him for forgiveness, for healing, and for comfort, all of these things for us. He tells our Father of our gratitude, our pleas, and our vague murmurings. When I think about this, my worry truly does fade away. I am comforted knowing that, in my death, I will reach that Heavenly home where eternity will be filled with all things good for my soul.
