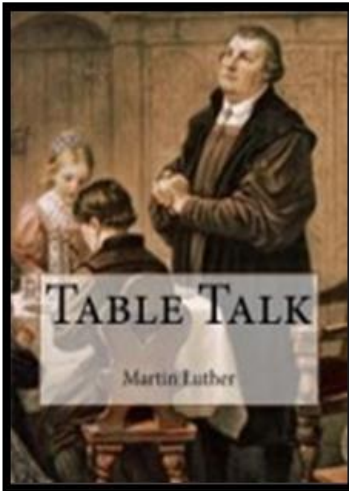


TABLE TALK ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL DISCUSSION GROUP

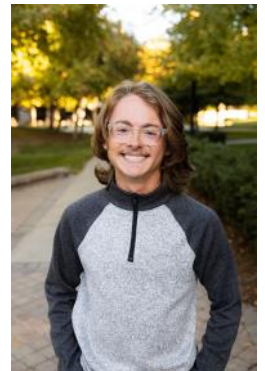

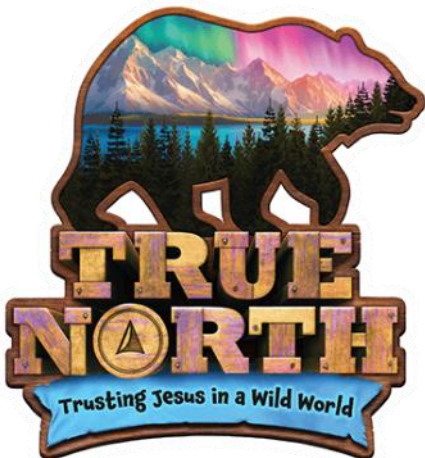

Zephaniah 3:17 – “The Lord your God is in your midst, a might one who will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness; He will quiet you by His love; He will exult over you with loud singing.”

Easter has come. Christ has risen. We shout and sing, “Hallelujah!” Our Savior, who had been made man, has died and has ascended into Heaven. What next?
